#### Purpose and legal basis of the processing

#### Categories of recipients of personal data

#### Right of revocation for consent

#### Data subject rights

According to the General Data Protection Regulation, you have the following rights:

- If inaccurate personal data is processed, you have the right to rectification (Article 16 DS-GVO).
- If the legal requirements are met, you may request the erasure or restriction of processing as well as object to processing (Article 17, 18, 21 DS-GVO).
- If you have consented to the data processing or if a contract for data processing exists and the data processing is carried out with the help of automated procedures, you may have a right to data portability (Article 20 DS-GVO).
